ELECTORAL COURT: REYNO DAWID DE BEER v ELECTORAL COMMISSION - CASE NO 27/2024EC; UMKHONTO WESIZWE PARTY v ELECTORAL COMMISSION

- 1 We represent the Electoral Commission in the application by the uMkhonto weSizwe Party in the Electoral Court under case no. 0034/2024EC (the application).
